
CERAMIC TABLE

With a little care you can prolong the life of your furniture. Follow the instructions for the materials of your specific product to make sure that it stays in the best shape for as long as possible. The information below is only intended as a general guideline.

CAUTION

- Do not sit or stand on the ceramic surface.
- Do not use the ceramic surface as a chopping board.
- Do not strike the ceramic surface with hard or pointed items.
- Be careful not to scratch or damage the surface with sharp objects.
- Do not place hot or very cold items directly on the ceramic surface.

CLEANING & CARE


Always use coasters or table mats to protect the ceramic surface. When cleaning the ceramic surface, use a damp cloth with a suitable neutral cleaning detergent or a mild ceramic cleaner. Remove soap residue immediately using a clean, dry cloth. Do not use scouring cream or scouring pads, as they may scratch the glass surface.

CONCRETE

Wipe with a soft cloth wrung in clean water or a maintenance product for concrete. Avoid using scouring cream or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface. Never use vinegar, ammonia, acetic acid or citric acid.


STORAGE / OUTDOOR FURNITURE

The lifespan of your furniture will vary depending on the weather and type of use. We recommend that it is stored in a dry, ventilated place during winter and protected against scratches and bumps. Wipe off the furniture if it becomes wet after rain or snowfall as this will damage the surface over time. Make sure to wipe off any sun cream or other liquids from the furniture after use, as these can leave stains on the surface if left in direct sunlight.




Protect the product from scratches and other damage while assembling by using the packaging material as an underlay.

Never handle a damaged tabletop without gloves, as shards can be very sharp.



Turn the base A on its side.






Two people are required to carry out this assembly.

Never carry heavy items by yourself.


Keep holding the base on its side and insert the screws **B** into the base, ensuring the steel washer **C** is placed in between.




Connect the column **D** to the screws with the spacer **E** in between.

Make sure the plastic washer is facing the correct way, as illustrated.


Tighten the screws using the Allen key **H**. Alternate tightening the screws until both are tight.




Turn the base and column upright.




Place the washer **(F)**.




Connect the tabletop to the column with the screws **G** using the Allen key **D**. Do not fully tighten the screws.



Once all the screws are in place, go ahead and fully tighten them.
